COUNCIL MEETING  
MINUTES  
November 9, 2010

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, November 9, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Douglas Guillotte, June Hooper, Deborah Roberts, and Edith Williams.  
Absent: None.

Edith Williams opened the meeting with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes from the 10/12/2010 meeting were approved as written with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Hooper. All ayes.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.

Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mrs. Hooper and second from Mr. Guillotte. All ayes.

Mary M. Thompson, Chairman of Planning and Zoning presented the following report. It is recommended that an ordinance be adopted to rezone certain property along the East side of Highway 5 in the Town from LR-2 to LC/I to allow for Commercial Development. Suits against Bill Adams (A&P Bldg), 201 Main Street and Foster Gamble of 207 Marshall Road will be filed in District Court this Friday, 11/12/10.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Hooper proposed ordinance #681—the rezoning of certain property located on the East side of Highway 5 from LR-2 to LC/I allowing for commercial development, was introduced and a public hearing called for Tuesday, December 14, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. for public comments. All ayes.

A new group health policy with Humana was approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Roberts. All ayes.

The 2011 proposed budget was introduced and a public hearing called for Tuesday, December 14, 2010, for public comments with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.

Mr. Guillotte inquired about cutting the Industrial Site located on Highway 5. Mayor Freeman asked Mr. Guillotte to take care of finding someone to cut it.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Hooper. All ayes.
