

TOWN OF LOGANSPOURT
MINUTES
December 14, 2010

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, December 14, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Douglas Guillotte, Deborah Roberts and Edith Williams. Absent: June Hooper.

Mayor Freeman opened the meeting with prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

A public hearing was opened for public comments regarding proposed ordinance #681—Rezoning certain property located on the East side of Highway 5 from LR-2 to LC/I to allow for commercial development. There were no public comments.

Also, the public hearing was held for discussion of the 2011 proposed budget, but there were no public comments or questions. The hearing closed with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes, one absent.

Minutes from the 11/09/2010 meeting were approved as written with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes, one absent.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Roberts. All ayes, one absent.

Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes, one absent.

Linda Vidler presented the Planning & Zoning report, stating six properties had been cited for cleanup. She, also, informed the council that Mr. John Horn, owner of the property where Brandy Worsham has her mobile home, was in code enforcement court with Ms. Worsham and guaranteed the property would be cleaned up. Mrs. Vidler inquired as to the status of the riverfront stage. Mr. Clark stated the trusses had been ordered and the project should be completed by early next year.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Arbuckle, Ordinance #681—Rezoning certain property located on the East side of Highway 5 from LR-2 to LC/I to allow for commercial development, was adopted. All ayes, one absent.

The 2011 budget was approved with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes, one absent.

The 2010 budget was amended (copy attached), with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes, one absent.

There was a discussion as to whose responsible for removing the old boat dock on the riverfront behind Caraways. It was decided to refer the question to P&Z for research.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams.
