

TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR
MINUTES
June 11, 2013

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, June 11, 2013, at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Pro-Tem Norman Arbuckle presiding. Other Council members present: Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan, and Edith Williams. Absent: Mayor Katherine Freeman. Two guests were present.

The meeting opened with prayer by Edith Williams and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The May minutes were approved as written with a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Morvan. All ayes.

Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mr. Cordray a resolution was adopted levying a general alimony tax of 7.49 mills on all property subject to taxation by the Town of Logansport. All ayes.

With a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mrs. Guillotte, THE ENTERPRISE was approved as the official journal for the Town of Logansport for period beginning 7/01/2013 through June 30th, 2014. All ayes.

A resolution adopting a Citizen Participation Plan for the CDBG Program was approved with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

The Clerk presented the Council with the Public Awareness/Damage Prevention Notice that should be published annually in the newspaper and mailed to the Town's gas customers twice annually. The notice informs the public of natural gas hazards and prevention measures. Each council member completed a survey questionnaire.


The Council was informed of all the damage related to the storm on 6/2/13, which caused an electrical problem and irreparable damage to the modem, 2 routers, 3 PC's and 1 Monitor.

The Clerk also informed the Council of the sewer problems at St. Luke's Baptist Church and of their request to put in a septic tank. With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Morvan it was approved to allow St Luke's Baptist Church to install their own septic tank, but the church must provide the Town with verification that it meets with the Parish requirements. All ayes.

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Drainage and the cleaning of ditches was discussed. The Town does not have the manpower or the proper equipment to get all the problem ditches cleaned out. A suggestion was made to ask the DeSoto Parish Police Jury for assistance since the Jury has the proper ditching equipment. Public Works Director, Rex Clark, will look into this possibility.

With no further business to discuss the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mrs. Williams.
