The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, April 8, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Six guests were in attendance.

Frankie Mathis, pastor of Cornerstone Cowboy Church, opened the meeting with prayer. Mayor Freeman led the Pledge of Allegiance.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle the March minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

General fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Guillotte. All ayes.

Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mrs. Williams and second d from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Brother Frankie informed the Council of the plans to restore and renovate the building at 113 3rd Street for the benefit of the Town and the surrounding communities. Cornerstone Ministry plans to use the finished building to offer assistance to people needing food and clothing. Counseling will also be available to help the people of our area physically, emotionally and spiritually. He is hoping to obtain some grant money to help with the project. The Council voiced their support of the project.


Christmas Lighting Festival Chairman, Debbie Amox, requested permission to move the Christmas Lighting and Festival from the weekend after Thanksgiving to the weekend before Thanksgiving, stating she felt the attendance would be better, due to so many people participating in the Black Friday sales events after Thanksgiving. With a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mr. Arbuckle, it was approved to move the festival to the weekend before Thanksgiving. All ayes.

A discussion to establish the weight limits for trucks traveling Town streets, as well as, requiring permits for heavy loads on Town streets ensued. No decision was finalized, therefore, no ordinances were introduced.


With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle a special Council Meeting was called for Tuesday, April 22, 2014 at 5:30 p.m. to set the Property Tax Millage Public Meeting. All ayes.

Mrs. Guillotte presented the Police report stating the sheriff's department responded to 109 calls in the month of March, resulting in 8 arrests and 24 citations. A total of \$5,271 was collected in fines.
