

TOWN OF LOGANSPORT
MINUTES
June 10, 2014

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, Jun 10, 2014, at 6:00 p.m. at Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, Dale Morvan and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Five guests were present.

The meeting was opened with the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Guillotte a public hearing was opened for comments on Ordinance #694—Establishing weight limits for motor vehicles travelling on municipally owned public streets and Ordinance #695— Requiring a written permit to transport goods and materials on municipally owned streets when load limits exceeds 12,000 pounds. After public comments the public hearing closed with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Ms. Guillotte.

Minutes from the 5/13/2014 were approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Both General fund and Utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Morvan and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.


The floor was opened for comments from anyone attending the meeting. Jean Borders (alias Queen Elizabeth as signed in guest register) inquired about any progress regarding property clean-up. She also asked had a new Code Enforcement Officer been hired and was told that the Town does not have the funds to hire a Code Enforcement Officer at this time and the Mayor is assuming those duties for the time being. She also commented on the stop sign at Gum and 7th Street needing to be moved for more visibility.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mr. Cordray, Ordinance #694—Establishing weight limits for motor vehicles travelling on municipally owned public streets was adopted. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mr. Morvan, Ordinance #695—Requiring a written permit to transport goods and materials on municipally owned streets when load limit exceeds 12,000 pounds. All ayes.

With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle a resolution levying a 7.49 property tax millage for the year of 2014 was adopted. All ayes.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mr. Morvan. All ayes.
