

MINUTES
TOWN OF LOGANSPOUR
August 11, 2015

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, August 11, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, June Hooper, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Seven guests were in attendance.

The meeting opened with the Lord's Prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Freeman presented DeSoto Fire District #1 Fire Chief Rusty Canton with a Plaque of Appreciation for the outstanding fireworks show on the riverfront July 4, 2015.

July minutes were approved as written with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

Monthly bills were approved with a motion from Mrs. Hooper and second from Mrs. Guillotte. All ayes.

Gary Hobbs, candidate for DeSoto Parish Sheriff, addressed the Council citing his reasons for running for the position.

Todd Eppler, Administrator of the DeSoto Regional Health System, notified the Council that the Logansport clinic would be moving to its new location as soon as the inspection process had been completed. He, also, informed the Council that Golden's Eye Clinic in Center, TX was interested in leasing the old clinic building that is located on Town property and asked if the Town would be interested in participating in such a lease. It was agreed that a 1 year lease at \$800.00 a month (\$400.00 to Town & \$400.00 to DeSoto Regional) with an option to renew seemed reasonable. With a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle it was approved to allow Mr. Eppler to negotiate with Golden's on behalf of the Town and report back for final approval. All ayes.

Mrs. Guillotte presented the police report stating there were 141 calls responded to and 23 citation issued and a total of \$1773 collected in fines for the month of July.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mrs. Hooper.
