

TOWN OF LOGANSPORT  
MINUTES  
January 13, 2015

The regular meeting of the Logansport Town Council was held Tuesday, January 13, 2015, in the Council Chamber of Logansport Town Hall with Mayor Katherine Freeman presiding. Council members present: Norman Arbuckle, Judge Cordray, Martha Guillotte, and Edith Williams. Absent: None. Six guests were in attendance.

The meeting opened with prayer from Edith Williams and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Freeman presented a plaque to Debbie Amox, Chairman of the Christmas Lighting Festival, in appreciation of her time and dedication this year and years past in "lighting up" Logansport for the Christmas season.

With a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams, the December minutes were approved as written. All ayes.

Both general fund and utility fund bills were approved with a motion from Mr. Cordray and second from Mr. Arbuckle. All ayes.

During the public comment session, John Paul Moore complained about the speeding on Willow and Lee Streets in his neighborhood. He said the "Children at Play" sign had not helped at all. Linda Hall and Cynthia Hendrickson also complained about the speeding on their side of town. Mayor Freeman asked them all to report it to the sub-station. They all said they had reported it, but nothing had been done. It was suggested that Deputy Carol Sue Richardson be asked to attend council meetings to answer questions regarding the policing of Logansport.

Also, during the public comment session, Debbie Amox expressed concern over several problem areas in the park. She stated the sidewalk leading from the parking area on the north side of the substation needed some repair work. Also, all the sidewalks and walking trail need weed eating and edging. The crepe myrtle trees need pruning and ant beds need to be poisoned. She also inquired about the drainage along the street by the riverfront.

Mrs. Guillotte gave the police report stating there were 155 total calls with 25 citations and 8 arrests with total fines collected of \$2,114.00 for the month of December.

With no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned with a motion from Mr. Arbuckle and second from Mrs. Williams. All ayes.
