A Safe Place

WHERE people with habits, addictions, hurts and hang-ups gather to experience and to celebrate God's healing power. This experience opens the door to change as we share our experiences, strengths and hopes with one another. In addition we become willing to accept God's grace in solving our life problems.

We grow spiritually by working through the steps and applying the Biblical principles. We become free from our addictive, compulsive and dysfunctional behaviors. This freedom creates peace, serenity, joy and most importantly a stronger personal relationship with God and with others.

Road to Recovery Principles:

- ♦ **R**ealize I'm not God. I admit I am powerless to control my tendency to do wrong things and that my life is unmanageable in areas or completely.
- ♦ **E**arnestly believe that God exists, that I matter to Him and that He has the power to help me recover, heal and live victoriously.
- ♦ **C**onsciously choose to commit all my life and will to Christ's care & control.
- ♦ **O**penly examine and confess my faults to myself, to God and to someone I trust for healing & freedom.
- ♦ **V**oluntarily submit to every change God wants to make in my life and humbly ask Him to remove my character defects.
- ♦ **E**valuate all my relationships. Offer forgiveness to those who have hurt me and make amends for harm I've done to others, except when to do so would harm them or others.
- ♦ **R**eserve a daily time with God for self-examination, Bible reading, and prayer in order to know God and His will for my life and to gain the power to follow His will.
- ♦ **Y**ield myself to God to be used to bring this Good News to others, both by my example and by my words.
